And notwithstanding, the organization has a Single Parents Support Program that supports single parent self-help groups to combat isolation and stress which includes a week's holiday camp for single mothers and their children. And last, ZIWA have a Business Networking Program designed to support new and existing business-women with a ZIWA Business Directory, and throughout the year, runs a series of business networking, exhibition and support events.
